

Information according to article 33 on the REACH candidate substance Bisphenol A

Against the background of a maximum supply and product safety we would like to meet our information obligation according to Article 33 of the REACH regulation for Substances of Very High Concern for Authorization (SVHC)

The products listed contains above 0.1 % weight of the substance Bisphenol A, which is on the SVHC Candidate List dated January 12th 2017 pursuant to Article 59 (1,10) of the regulation (EG) 1907/2006 („REACH“):
